a life of joy and peace.

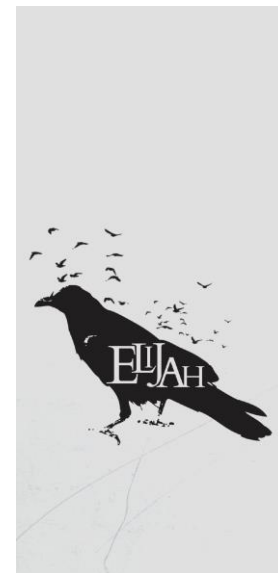

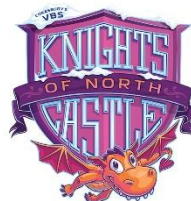
