### PARKING LOT FUND

Our parking lot has needed repairs for years. It has been deferred for other priorities including roof replacement & the organ purchase. It is again the top priority of the Trustees. Council has authorized a Parking Lot Fund to collect specific donations for this purpose. All proceeds from the Easter breakfast were given to this fund. Council is researching the procedure of obtaining monies from our Endowment Fund.

The Trustees have obtained a \$70,000 proposal to replace defective curbing, re-align the driveway to the alley and create several additional parking spaces. Then the entire lot will be resurfaced and striped. Please see the diagram on the bulletin board in the hallway. This price is only valid for this summer and, given inflation and the cost of materials, it will likely cost more next year.

We are still far from this \$70,000 goal, but we know we can do this! Please consider your contribution to the Parking Lot Fund.
